

Instructions for submission

The International Track is for papers written in English and directed to an international audience. The Iberoamerican track accepts papers in Spanish or Portuguese. Papers in both tracks will undergo rigorous peer review.

Paper categories are the same for both tracks:

- Full research papers (up to 12 pages)
- Short research-in-progress papers (up to 8 pages)
- Project presentations (up to 8 pages)

All submissions must be done through the [EasyChair system](#)

International track

Submissions must be written in **English**.

Best papers submitted to the International track will be published in [Elsevier's Procedia](#) proceedings series. The rest of the papers will be published in the local CDROM proceedings. 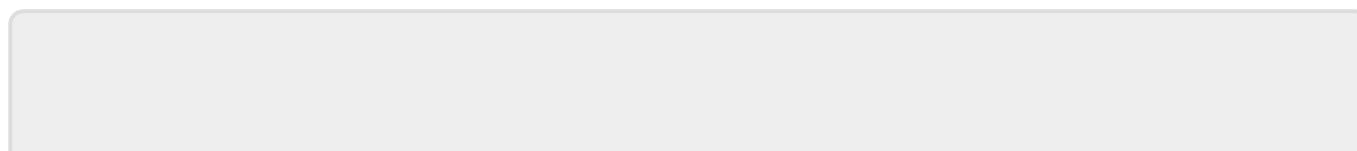
Iberoamerican track
